As a community-based organization, Brotherhood Incorporated is committed to providing supportive services to individuals who do not have access to basic necessities for daily life. As part of our PrEP program, the Peer Navigator has identified that many of our clients have difficulty accessing a variety of services due to issues such as their appearance, inability to communicate effectively, difficulty reading and filling out forms, as well as many others. We should remind ourselves that when someone is hungry their mind is not focused on their overall well-being, but rather they only concentrate on their needs in the moment. We have developed the care box program in order to help the most disadvantaged members of our community live healthier and more fulfilled lives.

The purpose of the care box is to provide our community with goods during our normal service hours. Individuals will be able to come and request the product(s) they need most such as:

Clothing:

Shoes, Men & Women's T-shirts, pants, underwear, bras, socks, etc.

Perishable food items:

Can soups, Granola bars, Packaged meats, Sardines, Tuna cans, Peanut butter, Gift cards (fast food restaurants), soft drinks, water bottles, etc.

Household Toiletries:

Shampoo & Conditioner, Tampons, Soap bars, baby oil, Deodorant, Hair products, Body spray, Hand sanitizer, skin lotion, moisturizer, tissues, Q-tips, mouthwash, toothpaste, razor, vitamin C, cough drops, dental floss, face wipes, liquid laundry detergent.
